

ROAD CLOSURE

BROADWAY BOULEVARD/N2 INTERCHANGE DEVIATION

Upgrades to Broadway Boulevard are ongoing as part of the City of Cape Town's congestion alleviation programme, which has been implemented in a phased approach. Great progress has been made to date.

Construction of two 2.5 m-wide bridges for pedestrians and cyclists, adjacent to the N2 overpass will commence. Drivers should expect temporary lanes closures of the N2 during the night, from 16 to 19 November 2019.

Traffic at the Broadway Boulevard (R44) / N2 interchange will be deviated overnight to allow for the installation of bridge beams over the N2. Note that road users can still access the exit ramps onto the N2.

N2 traffic travelling towards the interchange will be subject to deviations as follows:

- Saturday, 16 November 2019, 20:00 - 06:00
- Sunday, 17 November 2019, 20:00 - 05:00

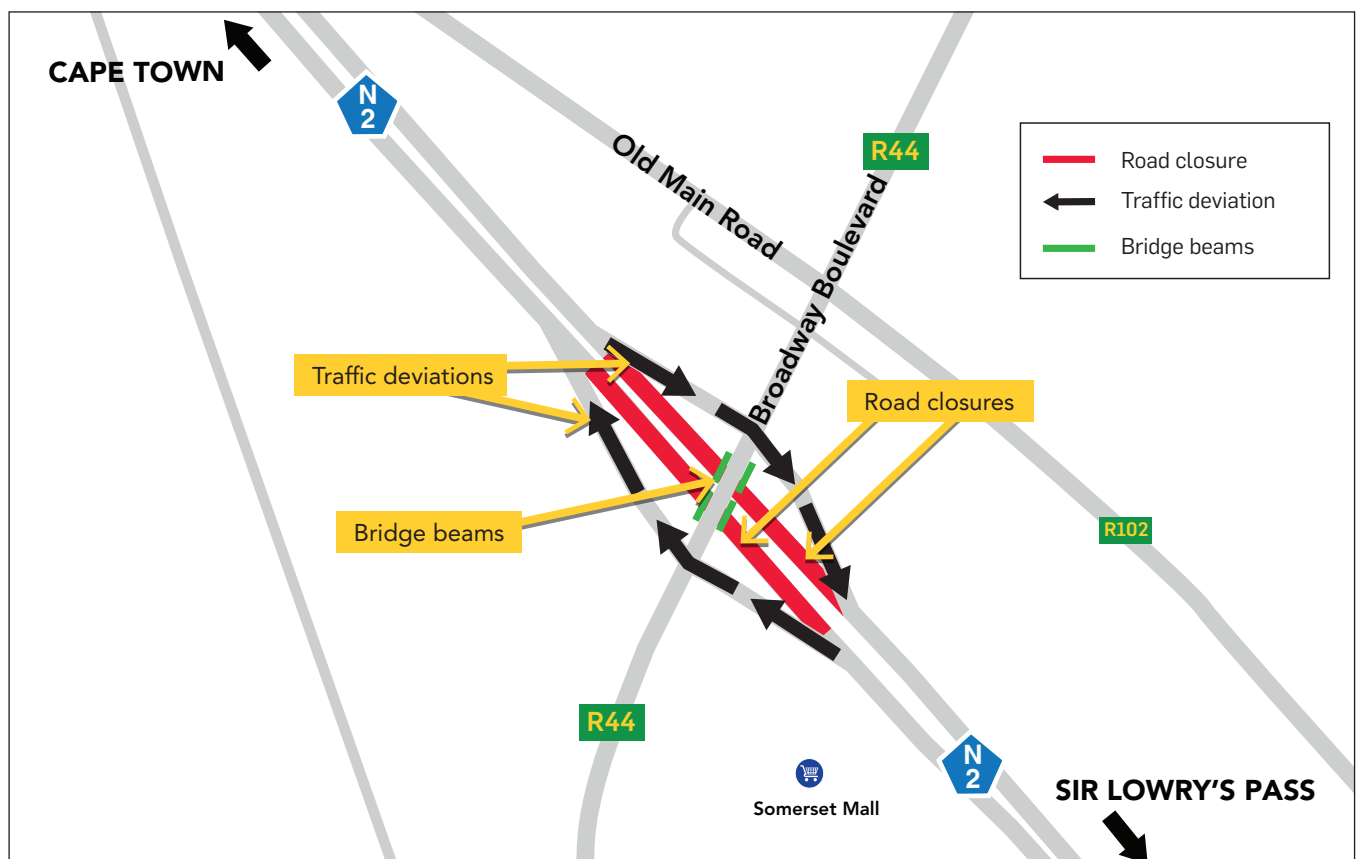
- Monday, 18 November 2019, 21:00 - 05:00
- Tuesday, 19 November 2019, 21:00 - 05:00

Initially, only the N2 inbound carriageway will be closed. Once the beams have been installed over the inbound carriageway, the outbound carriageway will be closed and the inbound carriageway reopened. The N2 carriageways in both directions will be fully opened once all beams are in place.

Motorists are advised to use alternative routes to avoid delays. Signage boards with alternative detours will be placed at key interchanges and intersections.

The following alternative detour routes should be considered:

- Victoria Road / N2 intersection
- Macassar Road Exit Ramp / N2
